OC - (22961) - GENDER DIFFERENCES IN DOMESTIC TASKS AND CHILDCARE AMONG IMMIGRANTS IN PORTUGAL

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The present communication aims to analyze gender differences in unpaid work, namely domestic tasks, and childcare. An online survey was administered to 206 immigrants in Portugal, 151 females, 54 males, and 1 non-binary person, aged between 19 and 77 years old ($M = 35.2$; $SD = 11.3$). The results indicate gender disparities in the amount of time dedicated to domestic tasks and childcare, in the typologies of unpaid work performed by immigrant women and men, and in its economic value, with women subjected to workload and economically harmed. Burden of immigrant families is aggravated when they have children under 12 years old, which suggest the necessity to reframe policies and measures that can contribute to a better labor and social integration, especially for women.
