This article explores the role of internet community radio in the Palestinian resistance, focusing on its potential to embody care. This research aims to understand the importance of community radio in shaping and disseminating the Palestinian narrative and identity, while also assessing its contribution to the Palestinian liberation struggle. The study employs a digital ethnography of Radio Alhara as a study case, with interviews with artists and people connected to the radio. Adopting a feminist and decolonial approach to research, this study interlinks community radio and Palestinian history from an ethic of care perspective. The main goal of this paper is to assess the extent to which community radio can be a form of resistance, driven by its existence as a community promoter and its potential to foster care networks, and therefore assist the path towards Palestinian liberation.
